## IBM OmniFind Enterprise Edition

### 1a

IBM OmniFind Enterprise Edition makes enterprise content more easily accessible to help organizations increase ROI from Enterprise Content Management and Collaboration investments. This demonstration shows the out-of-the-box features of OmniFind Enterprise Edition that enable you to quickly create a rich, unified, and secure search experience across Collaboration, ECM and Database content.

### 4a

OmniFind Enterprise Edition ships with an easy to use search application.

### 4b

A basic search for the word “survivor” returns a list of results from a Domino “Reality TV Discussion” database.

### 4c

Results are sorted by relevance, or by any other metadata field.

### 4d

Results can also be filtered by file type or by source type. Connectors are available for searching more than 30 enterprise content sources, including IBM FileNet P8, IBM Content Manager, EMC Documentum, all of the major databases, SharePoint, Lotus Quicker, file systems, and others.

### 5a

A link to the Wikipedia page for “survivor” is featured at the top, indicating that this is the most commonly visited page for the query “survivor.” Quick Links are very easy for administrators to configure.

### 5b

The relevance score for each document is displayed, along with a dynamic summary of the content, as well as some metadata.

### 5c

Additional metadata can be displayed by hovering over the metadata icon, or by clicking “Show details.”

### 6a

Lotus Notes documents can be opened in HTML format or with the Lotus Notes client using the client viewer.

### 6b

In addition to generating a standard list of search results, OmniFind Enterprise Edition categorizes the top results by metadata fields, using dynamic bar charts.

### 6c

In this example, top results are grouped by the “category” and “author” fields. Other fields can be selected from the drop-down menu for analysis.

### 6d

Clicking on a bar chart refines the search to show only the results for the selected item: in this example, documents pertaining to Survivor in Guatemala. This helps users find what they're looking for much faster.

### 6e

The number and type of charts is easily configurable using a graphical layout tool, as we will see in a moment.

### 6f

There's also a chart that can return custom links, or be extended to search any repository or index: for example, Dogear, IBM's social bookmarking tool.

### 7a

Users can also issue semantic or concept searches, from the Basic Search tab, right out of the box.

### 7b

To enable semantic search, a user simply clicks a radio button in the preferences tab.

### 7c

A search for "IBM support phone number" will now highlight actual support phone numbers, as opposed to finding only the keywords.

### 8a

Now let's take a look at an example of a multi-parameter search.

### 8b

The user wants to find all articles in the last 45 days containing the term "enterprise portal."

### 8c

There's an easy-to-use widget for specifying date ranges.

### 8d

Only results containing the phrase within the specified date range are returned.

### 8e

We now return to our search on the word "Survivor"

### 9a

The search application we've been demonstrating is very easy to customize using a graphical layout tool, which is accessed from the Web-based administration console.

### 9b

There are over a hundred customization options to choose from, including changing screen navigation menus, images, options for how results are displayed, and more.

In this example, an administrator removes the Advanced Search tab and changes the theme with just a few clicks. Changes can be previewed instantly.

### 9d

Top Results Charts can also be easily configured. Here, an administrator quickly changes the “author” chart to the “date” field.

### 9e

He then removes the field drop-down, and changes the color of the bar charts.

### 9f

Results are now grouped by date, instead of by author, and the color of the charts changes from blue to red.
