### Lotus Sametime 7.5 - Web Conferencing

#### 1a <0:00>

With over 150 new and enhanced features, IBM Lotus Sametime 7.5 represents a significant upgrade in real-time collaboration capabilities. Sametime 7.5 includes a completely re-designed web conferencing user experience, making it easier than ever to join and participate in an online meeting.

#### 1b <0:00>

Minh Li, an employee at ZetaBank, moderates a web conference with a group of her peers. In this meeting, they will preview a presentation that Minh is planning to deliver to upper management.

#### 1c <0:00>

In addition to each attendee's current online availability setting, the new Meeting Room Client displays Minh's meeting connectivity status. If her connection is interrupted, the client will automatically attempt to reconnect to the meeting, and update this status accordingly.

#### 1d<0:00>

The new tabbed user interface lets her proceed directly to the PowerPoint slides attached to the online meeting. She can advance sequentially through the presentation, or go directly to a specific slide.

#### 1e<0:00>

Slides may be re-sized, and the presentation area can be displayed in fullscreen mode.

#### 1f <0:00>

A complete set of markup tools is available to highlight and emphasize slide content. Minh uses the new laser-pointer feature to bring specific elements of the bar graph to the attention of the attendees.

#### 1g <0:00>

The highlighter is another way she can focus on important details. These tools enable presenters to effectively communicate key points, and visually enhance the online meeting experience.

#### 1h <0:00>

If necessary, Minh can attach and share additional presentation material while the meeting is in progress. The new material will be accessible in sequential order after the original PowerPoint slides.

### Lotus Sametime 7.5 - Web Conferencing

As the attendees view the next slide, Minh receives a message in the group chat window from Pierre Dumont, offering to add the missing information to the current slide.

#### 2b <0:00>

To enable this, she uses the enhanced application sharing feature of Sametime 7.5. She can easily share the entire screen, a portion of it, or in this case, only the PowerPoint application, to ensure the security of other applications and data on her own system.

#### 2c <0:00>

Once the application is shared, Minh can manage the session using a pop-up toolbar that allows her to stop sharing, change what is being shared, and give up or reclaim control of the shared application. Here, she allows Pierre to temporarily take control.

#### <TRANSITION TO AFTER SLIDE UPDATE IS COMPLETE>

#### 3a <0:00>

Later, with the slide update complete, Minh reclaims control of her screen and then ends the application sharing session.

#### 3b <0:00>

Moving to the shared whiteboard, we see that the team has been brainstorming on ways to update and improve the next quarterly review. New in Sametime 7.5 is the ability to edit existing text on the whiteboard, simply by clicking on the text area. Minh's edits are immediately visible to all attendees.

#### 3c <0:00>

The shared whiteboard also provides the same markup toolset as the Slides feature, and allows all authorized meeting presenters to make changes.

#### 3d <0:00>

The new Sametime Meeting Room Client continues to provide integrated video and audio support, and innovative capabilities such as the sending of web pages and instant polls to meeting attendees.

#### 3e <0:00>

IBM Lotus Sametime, the most widely-used instant messaging and web conferencing software solution, provides advanced organizational collaboration tools that help businesses bring teams together more effectively, reduce costs, and improve productivity and responsiveness.
